Airport Self Inspection Program

About:

This course will provide aerodrome inspectors with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitude to ensure that aerodrome inspection procedures are implemented appropriately, in order to achieve the goal of safe and efficient aerodrome operations.

What you will learn:

Upon completion of this course, you will be able to:

- 1) Understand the ICAO requirements for aerodrome facilities to insure that meet (SARPs).
- 2) Understand the requirements for the establishment of the stat legal framework supporting aerodrome certification.
- 3) Understand and conduct an aerodrome surface inspection and navigational aids (NAVAIDs).
- 4) Verify airside access and movement and conduct an inspection for the application of safety measures in the airside.
- 5) Verify the safety management system (SMS).
- 6) Inspect the presence of wildlife and aerodrome rescue and firefighting services (ARFFS).
- 7) Use Inspection Checklist.
